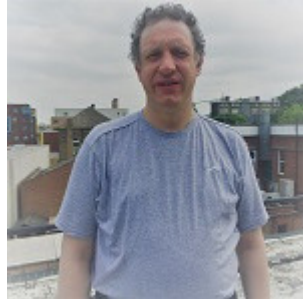




ANDREW MEYER
