SeeAbility does lots of work to make sure people with learning disabilities get the eye care they need as we know people are more likely to have problems with their eyes.

We do this by making people with learning disabilities, supporters and professionals '**Eye Care Aware**' at exhibitions, conferences and training sessions.



We have got some funding from the **Community Lottery Fund** to employ four new **Eye Care Champions** to join **Scott Watkin BEM** and our Eye Care and Vision Team to make more people 'Eye Care Aware'.



We need 2 Eye Care Champions for the **North West** and 2 for **London**.

The job will mean travelling around in these areas.



We have one job in each area for people with **lived experience of learning disability and/or autism** and one job in each area for people who have **experience of working in health, social care or voluntary services**

People in each area will be **co workers** and share their skills to do the job together



The jobs are **full time** at 5 days a week or can be **part time** at 2 or 3 days a week

The working hours can be flexible and change each day



The **wages** are £23,500 per year for working full time at 5 days per week

Any travel expenses are paid for too



We will be advertising the jobs on SeeAbility's website in **March**

The last day to apply will be **22nd March**
