Update from Boris Johnson the Prime Minister

Last night the Prime Minister Boris Johnson did an update about the Coronavirus on television.



The Government's plan to end lockdown had said that all of the rules about Coronavirus would end on the 21st June.



But this has now been changed to 19th July.

This is because the number of people catching Coronavirus is going up.



Also, the number of people going into hospital with Coronavirus is going up.

Most people in hospital with Coronavirus have not had the vaccine or have only had one dose of the vaccine.



The government wants more people to have had the vaccine before the rules change.



They want everyone over the age of 18 to be offered their first vaccine by the 19th July.

So for now, most lockdown rules will stay the same.



The only change is that weddings and funerals can take place for more than 30 people from June 21st

People at weddings and funerals must still social distance.



The government have said they will keep checking how many people have the Coronavirus every day.

This helps them make sure the rules about Coronavirus are the right rules.



The government said that by 19th July, all lockdown rules should come to an end.
