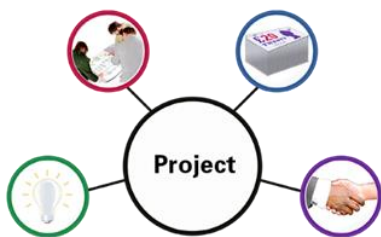




Choosing and Finding where to live:

How we will do this work

The people working on the project will include

- People with learning disabilities who have thought about their own housing choices or plans with others
- Family members who have supported their family member or others on housing choices
- People who know about housing
- People who know about support services

These people will be asked to do it as part of their job or we will pay for their time.

What we will do by working together

We will work together to



- 1. Make a guide on housing choices for people with learning disabilities and autistic people**

The guide will help people understand housing choices and what they can do to get the home they want.

- 2. Make a guide on housing choices to help commissioners do their job.**

The guide will help paid supporters and commissioners who plan and buy services to understand good ways of helping people get housing and support.

It will include examples to help all areas plan and organise good housing choices.



3. Share some examples and stories from people who have a home they wanted

We will ask people if they want to share the story of how they got their home or how they work to help a lot of people get their home
