




The ugly numbers



Across the UK, Black children are more likely than white children to be arrested. (Barnardo's 2020)



In England, Black Caribbean children are more likely to be excluded from school than all other children at primary, secondary and special schools. (Barnardo's, 2020)

The ugly numbers

People with learning disabilities were more likely to die from coronavirus than people without learning disabilities.

40 out of every 100 deaths of people with a learning disability from Covid were people from Black and Pakistani communities. (Race Equality Foundation, 2021)

Between 2018 and 2020 for men with the label of severe or profound



Men from a minoritised ethnic community died on average at age 33.




So, how do we make change happen?




