Council Tax is a fee you pay to your local council.



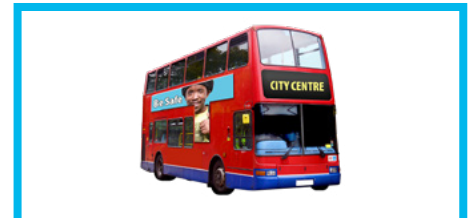
The cost is set by your council and it goes towards funding local services like:
