
## In 2021 We ran Leeds Take Action for UK Parliament Week

Education	Provides grants.	Provides Schools.
Roads	New motorways.	Repairs local roads. Street lighting.
Rubbish	Sets targets for recycling.	Collects rubbish.
Social Care	Provides grants. Decides policy for the whole country.	Assesses people's needs. Funds social care.
Housing	Decides policy for the whole country.	Provides places to live. Makes decisions about planning applications.
Sport & Leisure	Provides grants.	Provides leisure services.
Taxes	Collects income tax.	Collects council tax.
Law & Order	Makes laws for the whole country.	Does things to stop anti- social behaviour. Licenses pubs & taxis.
